Project Description

- **Village Name: Seegur Hadi**
- **Geographical Location: Rajiv Gandhi National Park, Karnataka**
- **Direct Beneficiaries: 918**
- **Number of Houses: 152**
- **Main Occupation of the villagers: Fishing, hunting wild rabbits and other small animals, collecting gooseberry, honey, wood flower, working for the forest department.**
- **Number of Filters Distributed: 152**
- **Source of water: River water, artificial pond constructed by forest department for wild animals.**

Manufacturing Process of BSF units:

5 BSF units will be manufactured per day in our workshop and total 130 filters in a month. Proportionately mixed concrete is filled in to the very well oiled mold (we use only cooking oil to apply for mold) ; we leave it for 24 hours to cure and dismantle the mold. Later the curing process takes place where the filters are filled with water and cured for 15 days.

Finely cured filters will be selected checked by blowing the air through water tube to see whether they are functioning well, if in case we have blockage in the filters, they are attended immediately by our staffs and made clear they are free from blockages. Before painting the filters, we scrub the surface of the filter with the proper sand paper to remove all the uneven particles, and a coat of putty is applied to it and kept aside to dry for 15 to 20 minutes and again it is scrubbed for a smooth finishing. After these process 2 coats of oil based paint will be applied and kept to dry for a day.

The filter media are washed and packed accordingly in the separate bags.

Awareness creation and Meetings:

The Village which is selected where the BSF project to be implements from the Help of **PPI, USA** is informed the dates of our visit. During our visit to the village, our staffs go to each and every house and gather the basic information of their family like number of people in the family, income of the family; common health problems etc and they are informed to assemble in one place of the village where the Awareness camp will be held.

When all the People gather in mentioned place, our staff will be giving all the necessary information about the Bio-sand water filters usage and its advantages from regular consumption.

They will be explained how the filters can improve their health conditions and get rid of their present health problems that are caused by the consumption of contaminated water. Also tips to maintain the filter will also be demonstrated to the beneficiaries.

Transportation of filters to the village

Well painted filters will be picked and loaded to the Filter carrying trucks and tied the rope with the proper packing so that filter don't hit each other and get damaged during the transportation. This process will be completed a day before we leave to the village because loading, packing and tying the filters will almost need 4 hours.

In a separate truck the diffuser box and plates, water cans and required quantity of filter Medias will be loaded.

The trucks will usually leave the workshop in the early morning because the journey of 90 Kilometers will take approximately 5 hours to reach due to the bad conditions of the road. The trucks will be accompanied by our staff team.

Distribution and Installation of 152 Filters

Filters will be distributed to the beneficiaries to their door step and kept in the right place. Selecting the right place in their hut is very much important. Once the filter is installed it is very difficult to move it from one place to another and also we recommend the beneficiaries not the move they as there is a risk of damaging the filters and also disturbance of filter media.

Installation of the filter is the most important thing; even a small mistake by our staff will end up in the failure.

Proper quantity of media has to be poured inside accordingly.

Later water is poured in and the outflow of the filter will be measured.

After all the installation process is done, the beneficiaries are advised to change the water regularly for a week and not to consume the water until a week.

20 liter water Jug will also be provided along the filter to store the filtered water.

After all this process the beneficiary's signature/ thumb impression and details are collected in the application form and documented along with the GPRS location of the filter placed and the photo will be taken.

Follow-up Visits

As our Tribal people are not at all educated, they need regular follow-ups and awareness camps regarding the safe drinking water, health and sanitation. Our staffs visit the beneficiaries once in a month and check the filters thoroughly. They will also measure the out flow of the water to ensure that the filter mechanism is working perfectly.

Beneficiaries conveyed their greetings to PPI,USA

With the Grace of PPI, USA the inhabitants of this village have received Bio-Sand water filter where they can filter and drink the water they were consuming earlier.

People are very much happy to receive the filters, Each and every beneficiary have conveyed their greetings to the donors.

All the beneficiaries of the Seegur Hadi village have received water jug along with the filters to store the filtered water in it, usually the utensils used by our tribal people are very old and hence water jugs are extra boon to them.

All this good cause was made possible with the help of PPI and the sponsors, we (staff of Pragathi) thank you all on behalf of our poor tribal people for your enormous support being offered to them.
