Project Name: -Covid relief in Kanakapura villages -July 2021

Belaku Trust have successfully finished giving food kits to village communities who are deeply affected during this Covid time.

We were able to give food kits along with masks, sanitizer and soaps to 80 families from our 7 villages. It's been a very rewarding experience for Belaku team to help these needy families who were affected during this Covid time. We were able to identify the men and women who were unable for variety of reasons, to be able to support them and those who depend on them, during this pandemic.

The food kit which we have given has rice, ragi, wheat, oil, pulses, vegetables etc. We have provided soaps, masks and sanitizer to these 80 families. Since we budgeted for 75 families but we were able to give 80 families this is because we were able to get the provision in wholesale price.

We have told the recipients' about the PPI donation and the village people appreciated their help. After the beneficiaries received the kit, many of them visited Gelathis' house and thanked her for choosing them for this event. They have even said that no one recognized and helped them during this pandemic. Also mentioned that this food will be sufficient for them for at least 2 months. We have seen the tears in their eyes when they received the kits.

The village community members were also happy by this work. But some village people were complaining that they didn't get the kit, but we have explained them on what basis we have chosen the beneficiaries and later they agreed.

We have the satisfaction that we helped the needy people. Here is a story of a family. We have seen every family have different problems during this Covid period.

A young woman Meena is from the village Kadahalli. She is 30 years old. She has 2 daughters. Her husband has health problems and his legs were infected and the toes were removed, he can do small and simple work. They have their own house at village Kadahalli. At the time of her husband's illness Meena had borrowed money. To return the loan the family moved to work in a farm house. Both husband and wife were working in the farm house and getting Rs. 11,000 salary per month. Due to lockdown the farm owner sent them back to their village, so they have no work or income. They came back to home. In this critical situation Meena's mother in law provided food for them. When we came to know about her situation we contacted her and we provided the provision. Meena and her family thanked PPI and Belaku for this support when they were really in need.
