As the COVID-19 pandemic continued and erupted for the second time, the hopes of our children coming back to St'Anthony's tribal destitute home for this year also got postponed. Due to Government order our children were sent back to their villages to stay at their parents and relatives houses as the crowd of the children was more.

When our children were at St.Anthony Home they were fed 3 times a day with morning milk, evening snacks along with neither milk nor tea. But at their villages their parents could hardly afford 2 times meals for the children.

This issue kept triggering us, and then came to our mind to approach PPI for the help, through mail we made a request to Srinath Sir explaining him the situation of our children, and then we got a response with good news that PPI had funds for our children to provide dry ration kits.

We received the sum of rupees 1, 71,000/- on 27/07/2021 and the same was utilized for the following food materials consisted in dry ration kit provide for the children. The above amount was enough to provide the ration for our children and their family, So soon after we received the funds we purchased all the required food grains and other food materials for packing. We distributed total 93 kits for our children studying at St.Anthony's Home and these kits indirectly benefitted their siblings and parents too reaching approximately 375 people. Even the transportation of food kits to the villages was a easy go as we had our own new Goods carrying vehicle whis was provided by PPI, as the fuel cost have increased like anything (94/-Rs per liter diesel) renting a goods vehicle was also an very costly affair. Hence, I take this pride opportunity to thank each and every donor of PPI for your enormous support.

We are ever grateful to PPI for being with our children in this situation.
